

Imam Khomeini Port



The Islamic Republic of Iran with 2700 Kilometers of coastline in the north (Caspian Sea) and south (Persian Gulf) has access to the world's free waters. Therefore, this country with its vast ports has managed to recognize itself as an important corridor in global trade, in addition to helping the neighboring countries to benefit from this special privilege. Among Iran's ports, Imam Khomeini Port enjoys a peculiar significance due to its position in North-South, East-West transit corridor, and marine faculties as well as exclusive geographic position in the region and world.

Imam Khomeini Port is located at the extreme north- western end of the Persian Gulf and the natural khormusa waterway, 165 kilometers from the province. With 42 nautical miles in length and 250 meters width and the average depth of 20 meters, this waterway provides a soft and smooth bed for sailing of various

commercial ocean Liners and oil tankers from Imam Khomeini Port to different parts of the world.

Among Iran's commercial ports, Imam Khomeini Port with its 11 million square meters area is one of the largest and most significant commercial ports of the country.

This port's vicinity with Imam Khomeini Porto chemical Industries, as well as Arvand Trade free zone in Abadan, Khorramshahr and other major industries in Khuzestan have enhanced the port's significance

Annually nearly half of the country's non-oil exports are transported via this port. With its advantageous geographic location and economic situation as well as more than 70 years

of fruitful experience, Imam Khomeini Port has recognized itself as the nearest and most reliable commercial western port in Iran, housing nearly 70 percent of commercial, industrial, agricultural and residential population of the country. This port's vicinity with Imam Khomeini Port chemical Industries, as well as Arvand Trade free zone in Abadan, Khorramshahr and other major industries in Khuzestan have enhanced the port's significance.

The five-hundred seventy hectares interlands of Imam Khomeini Port, is the best place for investment in the field of transportation and transit of cargo, ready for establishing warehouses, oil and non- oil tanks, container yards and jetties for handling and storing dry bulk cargo such as grains, chemical fertilizer constructions materials, minerals; and liquid bulk cargo such as cooking oil, chemical and oil products, palletted goods and containers.
